# SINGULAR VS. PLURAL



**Singular** is when we only have 1 object .

Example: a butterfly



**Plural** is when we have 2 or more objects.

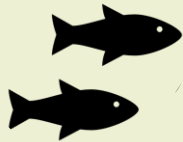
Example: three butterflies

# Irregular

- **Leaf** changes into **leaves** for plural



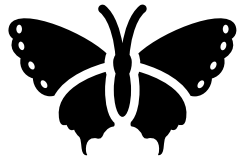

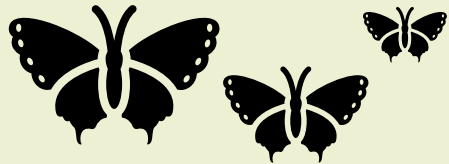
LEAVES

- Butterfly is different










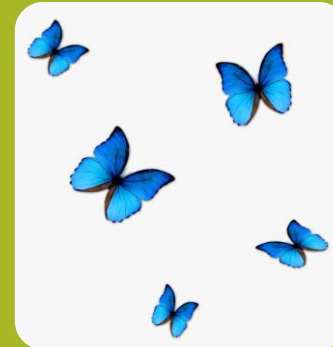
